- Minutes from the March meeting were approved
- Headwaters Trail Update
 - Trail looks good and is excellent shape
 - Beavers have built a dam across the river but should not pose a problem for the trail
- Pemberley/Carriage Cove Trail Update
 - A bridge (~18-20 feet long) is needed on the trail behind the Scuba Shop to cross the creek.
 - For the next workday, a trail has been flagged from the parking lot
 - One of the neighbors near the new easement has questions regarding property and easement lines. Bill Bruce is going to work them to clear up the confusion.
 - Suggested developing some signage to direct people where to park
- MST Campsite/Kiosk
 - Grayson, the Eagle Scout candidate, who is going to be improving the campsite as his project has raised most of the money and should be starting work soon.
- MST Reports
 - Martha is going to look into having small printed cards with information on the MST available to hand out to people on the trail and during workdays
 - The Town of Oak Ridge is now a “Friend of the Great Trails State Coalition”
- Community Outreach
 - Canine Capers – Martha is preparing all of the materials that we need for the event.
 - Next workdays to be scheduled in May for general maintenance
