

GUILFORD COUNTY DISTRICT 1 SHERIFF'S OFFICE CRIME STATISTICS FOR JANUARY 2025

For the month of January, the sheriff's office responded to 123 total calls for service in Oak Ridge town limits, resulting in 11 total case reports.

Of note:

- On 1/6, a 39-year-old male was arrested at the State Employee's Credit Union at 2047 Oak Ridge Road after being caught in the act of impersonating an account holder and attempting to fraudulently withdraw money from an account. He was charged with Felony Forgery of Endorsement, Felony Identity Theft, Felony Attempt to Obtain Property by False Pretense, Misdemeanor Possession of Fraudulent ID, Misdemeanor Resist Delay Obstruct a law enforcement officer and Driving While License Revoked.
- On 1/7, a 22-year-old female and former employee of Northwest Animal Hospital at 1694 NC 68 N was charged with Felony Larceny by Employee related to theft from the business.
- There were no other incidents or crime trends in the town for the month targeting the general public.
