

LIMITED ALCOHOL USE POLICY FOR 2023 MUSIC IN THE PARK

The following requirements will be observed for each sponsored *Music in the Park event in connection with the sale of alcoholic beverages and enforced by Town staff:

Any vendor of alcoholic beverages shall provide Town staff or designee with verification of its NC state alcohol sales permit.

The Town shall hire at least one off-duty sheriff deputy to monitor each event for general enforcement of park use regulations and specifically to watch for unruly behavior and people leaving designated alcoholic beverage use area with an alcoholic beverage.

Only event attendees verified by government-issued identification to be 21 years of age or older will be issued wrist bands by vendor indicating the ability to purchase an alcoholic beverage.

Attendees shall be limited to purchase two drinks per visit from a vendor.

Alcoholic beverages shall be consumed in the amphitheater area only. Town staff shall post signs around the amphitheater perimeter restricting consumption of alcoholic beverages to the amphitheater area.

This limited policy for each sponsored Music in the Park event in 2023 does not otherwise affect the existing park-wide “no alcohol” policy, which shall apply at all times to the park areas outside the amphitheater area as marked by said signage.
