GUILFORD COUNTY DISTRICT 1 SHERIFF'S OFFICE CRIME STATISTICS FOR FEBRUARY 2025

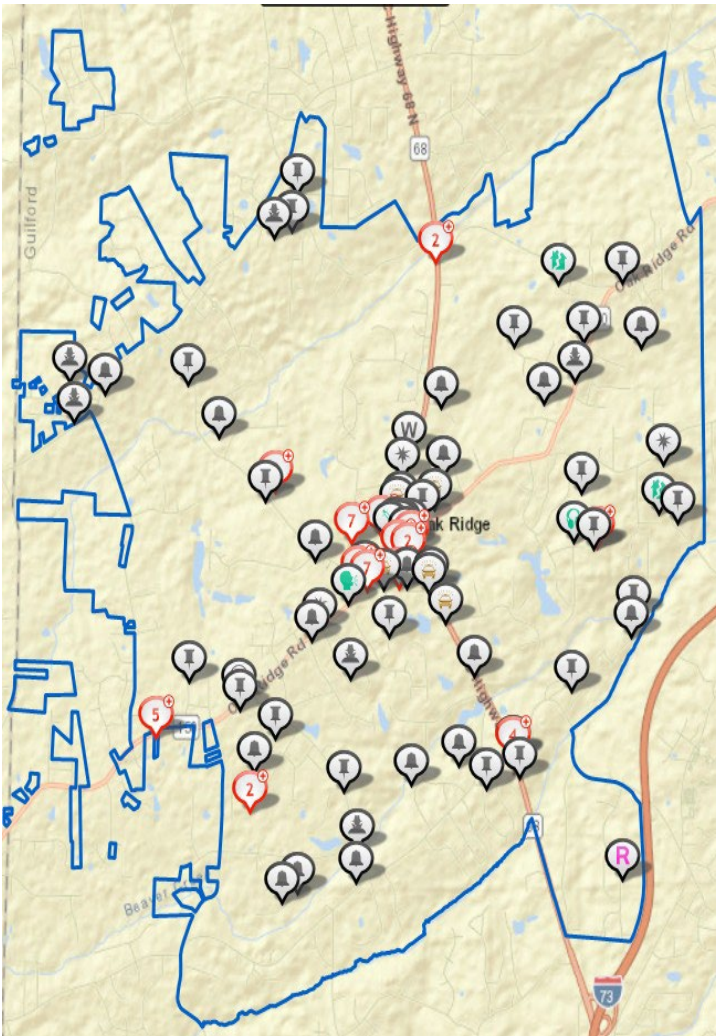
For the month of February, the sheriff's office responded to 112 calls for service in Oak Ridge town limits, resulting in 6 case reports.

Of note:

- On 2/18, deputies took a felony larceny report regarding materials being taken from a home under construction in the 7600-block of Elizabeth Drive. With the assistance of the Forysth County Sheriff's Office, a 30-year-old male from Kernersville was identified as the offender and was charged with Felony Larceny. All of the stolen property was recovered.
