

## GUILFORD COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT JUNE 2024 REPORT

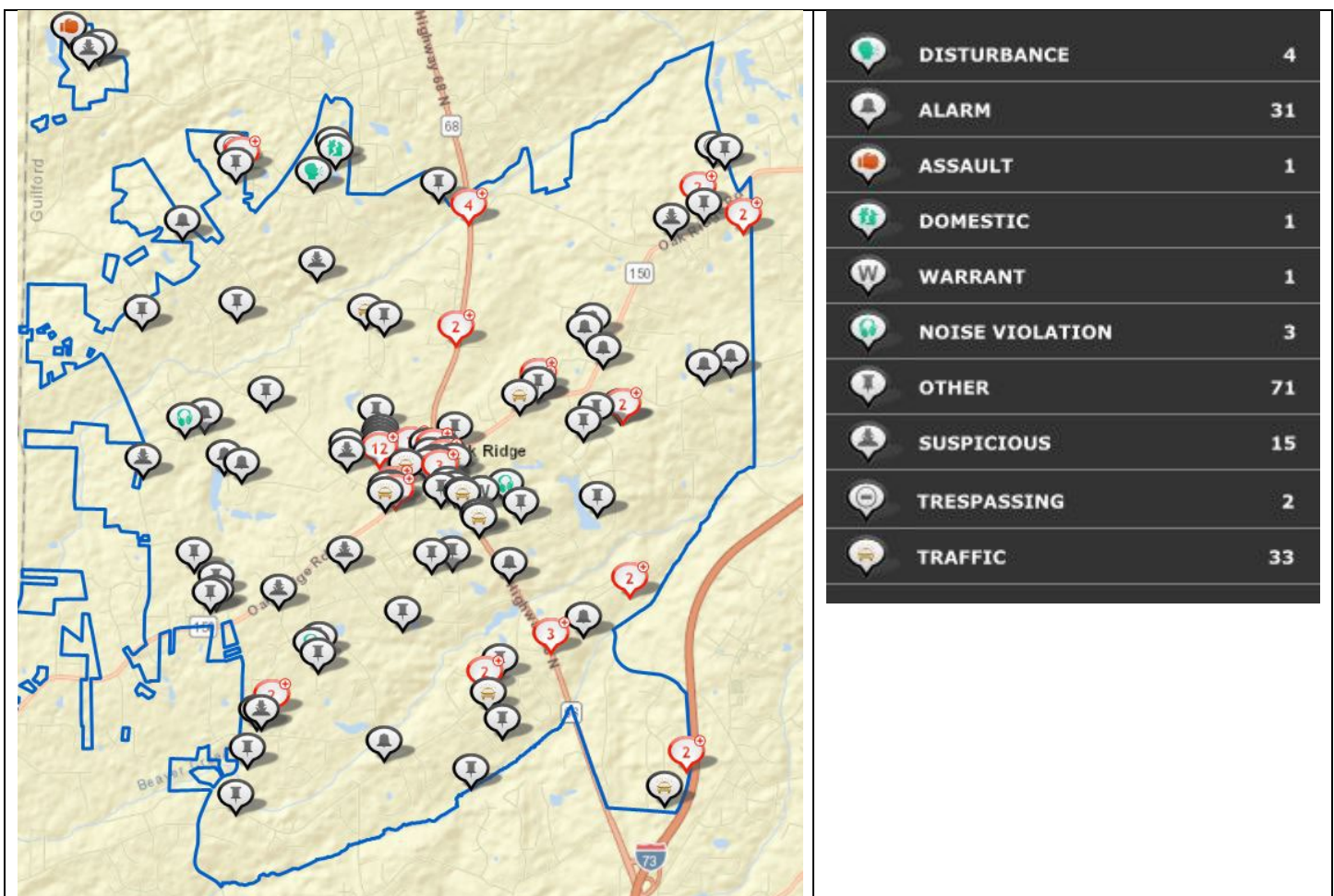
For the month of June, the sheriff's office responded to a total of **162** calls for service in Oak Ridge town limits and took **9** case reports.

### Of note:

- On June 10, the sheriff's office responded to a 911 call from Andrew Caetto of 7504 Skipper's Trace. During the incident, a deputy was shot during an altercation with Caetto. He suffered non-life threatening injuries. Caetto was charged with 1 count of Felony Assault with a Deadly Weapon with Intent to Kill Inflicting Serious Injury under N.C. General Statute 14-32(a), 3 counts of Misdemeanor Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer under N.C. General Statute 14-33(c)(4), and 1 count of Felony Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer with a Firearm under N.C. General Statute 14- 34.5(a) (**See the attached news release**)

### **D.H. ROGERS, SHERIFF NEWS RELEASE June 10, 2024**

Sheriff Danny H. Rogers reports that on June 10, 2024, at 1:23 a.m., the Guilford County Sheriff's Office (GCSO) responded to a 9-1-1 call from 54-year-old Andrew Ryan Caetto of 7504 Skippers Trace, Oak Ridge, NC 27310. Upon arrival, Deputies encountered Caetto, and subsequently, 29-year-old GCSO Master Corporal Dakota Brim was shot and transported to a local hospital and has since been released.

The GCSO arrested Caetto and transported him to the hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. Caetto has been charged with the following:

- (1) Felony Assault with a Deadly Weapon with Intent to Kill Inflicting Serious Injury under N.C. General Statute 14-32(a)
- (3) Misdemeanor Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer under N.C. General Statute 14-33(c)(4)
- (1) Felony Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer with a Firearm under N.C. General Statute 14-34.5(a)

He is currently being held at the Guilford County Detention Center in Greensboro under no bond. His first appearance is scheduled for June 11, 2024. There is no threat to the community.

As this is an ongoing investigation, no further details will be released at this time.
